

Healing Point House Rules

- **You must maintain absolute sobriety. No drug or alcohol use.** Non-compliance will be grounds for immediate dismissal from the house.
- **You are required to submit to a drug/alcohol urine screen or PBT** upon the request of staff at any time.
- **You must report and verify any prescribed medications to Healing Point staff.** All medication must be approved by staff and kept always secured in an issued lock box.
- **You must attend the weekly mandatory House Meeting for accountability.** Come prepared to discuss your participation in recovery activities from the past week.
- **You must pay your weekly program fee on time,** which is due at the weekly House Meeting.
- **You must work a 12-Step program and attend a minimum of three local meetings per week.** Note: it is highly suggested that individuals in early recovery attend daily meetings during their first 90-120 days of sobriety.
- **You must clean up after yourself in common areas. Your bedroom must also be kept clean.** No eating will be permitted in any sleeping area. Your bed is to be made when you are not in the bed, and room is to be free of clutter on the floor and in closets.

Healing Point House Policies

- **Discharge will be automatic in response to the following:**
 - **Stealing or destruction** of Healing Point House or any resident's property.
 - **Physical/verbal confrontation, violence or weapons** with any staff or resident.
 - **Any new arrest or criminal charge.**
 - **Sexual activity** in Healing Point House.
- **Curfew is 10:00 PM** and after 10 PM is quiet time. Volume of TV, music, or talking will also be kept to a minimum while others are sleeping. Any extensions to curfew must be approved in advance by Healing Point staff.
- **No one is allowed in another resident's room without their permission.** Do not go into other resident's rooms when they are not there.
- **No overnight guests are allowed.** All visitors to the property must be approved by staff and must be off the property by 9:00 PM.
- **No guests are allowed inside the house unless approved by Healing Point staff and in the presence of another member of the house.** Guests are only allowed in common areas, no guests allowed upstairs with exception of restroom use.
- **Each resident is responsible for the actions of their visitors while on the property.** Visitors to Healing Point will be asked to leave immediately if suspected of violating rules of the house or using illegal/illicit drugs/alcohol and will not be permitted back on the property.
- **Each resident and/or visitor will be solely responsible** for any personal property items brought into the house or on the grounds.

- **No TVs or personal computers are allowed in the bedrooms.** This is to promote socialization with your roommates as well as avoiding the isolation common to addiction.
- **Computer use will be limited** to job/school related activities and other approved use. Any unauthorized use for non-recovery recreational activities could result in dismissal.
- **Each resident will be allowed only one motor vehicle on the property.** Motor vehicles must have proof of license, insurance and registration on file.
- **Healing Point is a smoke-free facility. There is no smoking or vaping allowed in the house or garage at any time.** Smoking/vaping must occur outside, and cigarette butts must be placed in an approved container.
- **No pets allowed** at the Healing Point at any time.

Healing Point House Expectations

- **Show respect and positive regard for others.** Avoid attitudes and behavior that could adversely impact the recovery efforts of the other residents.
- **Show respect of neighbors within the community.** Be a good neighbor to help sustain a positive reputation for Healing Point.
- **Residents aware of other residents violating rules and regulations or breaking laws should report the occurrence to Healing Point staff.** Not sharing this knowledge could result in discipline and/or dismissal from the house.
- **Obtain a sponsor during your restriction period** at Healing Point and have this sponsor meet with Healing Point staff.
- **Become gainfully employed or be actively seeking full-time employment.** Employment should be secured within one month.
- **Personal cell phones are allowed** at the residence. Cell phone number as well as changes to your number must be shared with Healing Point staff.
- **You will record arriving and leaving the house in the Sign In/Sign Out sheet,** stating time frame and activity/location you will be at while away from the house.
- **You are responsible for your own meals.** Label your own food and drinks and do not take anything that is not yours. This constitutes theft and will result in dismissal from the house.
- **You are expected to conserve house resources.** Turn off lights, keep temperature at normal range, and use only the basic plan of TV and Internet provider. Failure to comply could result in an increase in program fees for all to offset utility charges.
- **You are expected to submit to person/room searches without prior notice.** Possession of weapons, pornography, drugs, alcohol, or other contraband will result in immediate dismissal.
