At the Opioid Treatment Center (OTC), our goal is to provide a comprehensive array of recovery treatments and psychosocial rehabilitation services to assist individuals in utilizing professional, community, and natural support systems to address their needs. We cannot achieve these goals alone; our community is in need and together we can effect change.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE PROGRAM?

- Must be 18 years or older
- May not be currently incarcerated
- Living with opioid or stimulant use concerns

FROM INTAKE TO RECOVERY

- 1 This is a voluntary program. Participants will have the option to stay in the program for as long as they need. Additional referrals to other community programs will be established prior to discharge.
- 2 OTC staff will contact all new referrals within 48 hours to complete an intake and schedule an assessment.
- 3 Participants will be assigned to a Recovery Support Specialist and meet within seven days. Together, they will create an Individual Recovery Plan that identifies goals, strengths, and barriers.
- 4 Each participant will meet with their Recovery Support Specialist weekly for case management.
- 5 Once per month, participants will have a team meeting with members of their identified support system to review the Individualized Recovery Plan.
- 6 Referrals are accepted from all sources; determination of program eligibility will be made by OTC staff.

THE OTC PROGRAM PROVIDES

- Education to the community
- Clinical treatment options
- Individual case plans
- Ongoing case management support
- Accountability
- Goal planning
- A person-centered approach
- MAT (Medication-Assisted Treatment)
- Referrals for local residential treatment placement options
- Financial assistance for treatment needs based on eligibility
- Reconnecting with family members

SAFE ACCESS POINTS

Dodge & Fond du Lac Counties offer A Safe Access Point for referrals and treatment. These are locations within the community that assist in finding help and support for anyone suffering with opioid or stimulant use disorders.
